



## Tab 29 – Secondary Schools

Item: 29.1

Special Allocation- Spring Harbor

Cut \$53,210. 1 FTE.

Analysis:

Middle school design implementation has already necessitated : reduction in French, elimination of drama, teaching responsibilities assigned to the learning coordinator, teachers scheduled outside of their grade level teams.

Additional 1.0 cut: cannot eliminate .5 counselor because of career awareness and wellness requirements. Cannot further combine music classes because of high demand.

The current class size at Spring Harbor is 21.0 The addition of 30 students, per grade level, would bring it up to 23.5 which is the same as O'Keeffe.

**Music:** Music classes meet for a full period every other day for the entire year

**Phy. Ed.:** Phy Ed meets for a full period, two times a week, for the entire year

**World Language:** Meets for a full period every day

**Art:** meets for a full period every other day for a semester

**Computer:** meets for a full period every other day for a semester

**Reading and Math Enrichment:** meets for 1 full period every other day for entire year Taught by academic teachers

**LMC :** .5 FTE

**Guidance Counselor:** 5 FTE

**Enrichment:** Taught by academic teachers

**Changes we have previously made to implement middle school design recommendation**

1. Reduced French to .3
2. Eliminated entire drama program
3. Cut EA position, now LMC must close due to fact there is a .5 LMC person, no one is in the LMC to supervise
4. Clerical cut to minimum level
5. Added 1 period in the master schedule to accommodate everyday foreign language
6. Added wellness class to be taught by learning coordinator out of LC allocation

7. All academic teachers will be teaching reading and math enrichment, some at different grade levels due to equity and contract hours

**Today's changes to eliminate 1.0 FTE**

- 1 Cannot combine music classes due to large number of students and small facility
- 2 Reading class was cut 4 years ago
- 3 Reducing counselor is not possible because she is implementing career exploration in the computer class and supports wellness teacher. Counselor has only .5 allocation
- 4 Change foreign language back to every other day would save .8
- 5 Social worker (.3) nurse ( .3) psychologist ( .3) will help implement wellness
- 6 We are still short .2

Item: 29.2

Eliminate Spring Harbor/Wright protection from 1 discretionary allocation cut

Cut \$106,320.

Analysis:

Spring Harbor see #29.1

Wright Middle School.

Middle school design implementation has already necessitated: combined 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> bands, eliminated Communication Arts classes, reduced time in 7<sup>th</sup> grade Read 180. eliminated drama.

Additional 1.0 cut would reduce learning coordinator to .5 and L.C. teaches 2 sections of math. Reduce Read 180 from 1.0 to .6. Cannot reduce .5 counselor because of career education and wellness requirement. Science and math teachers would be teaching outside their grade level or content area.

The current class size at Wright is 19.9. The addition of 30 students would bring it up to 22.4 which is closer to Sherman's 21.2.
