

**Tab # 56 -- Homeless Program**

- Questions:**
- 1) How many students are serviced in the Homeless Program?
  - 2) What are the costs for the Allied morning 2<sup>nd</sup> run and for how many students?
  - 3) How are homeless students getting to various schools?

**Response:**

- 1) As of April 30, 2006 there were 416 students identified as homeless in the Madison School District. This includes 27 students displaced by Hurricane Katrina.

As of May 9, 2006, the three TEP sites, Emerson, Lapham and Marquette, provided services to 124 students with 33 students currently attending those schools.

- 2) \$83.84 per day for the Allied Late Run - averaging 5 kids
- 3) Currently there are approximately 19 students on the TEP run  
Currently there are approximately 20 students on the Shuttle run  
Currently there are approximately 76 students being cabbed

A high percentage of the students being cabbed are "doubled up" in private residences and do not fit on the shuttle or TEP runs
