

TAB 82 - LIBRARY PAGES

Question 1: How are the library page positions hired? Are they hired from downtown or does each school hire their own?

Response: The library page positions are hired by the school from within their own Educational Assistant or Special Education Assistant staff. The library page hours are generally used to fill out their schedules. The schools have the following library page hours to work with:

High School	10 hours per week
Middle School	3 hours per week
Elementary School	9 hours

Question 2: How many people throughout the district hold these positions? What is the full-time; part-time status of these employees? Can the District require a person work full-time? If the District has a part-time employee, could the District mandate that person go full-time or eliminate the job and replace it with a full-time position?

Response: There are 55 different people who hold these positions across the district. All are employed at the school where they serve as library pages in other educational assistant or special educational assistant positions.

We can increase the number of hours an EA/SEA is assigned. It generally occurs at allocation time. We have increased the allocation during the school year when we had an extenuating circumstance such as high need student and a vacancy we couldn't fill.
