**Question:** What are the elementary supplemental allocations used for in each school?

**Analysis: Supplemental Allocations**

Elementary Supplemental allocations are used to support the School Improvement efforts of each school. Prior to the 2007-08 school year supplemental allocation was distributed at the discretion of each principal (usually to support a social worker, psychologist or coach). However, for the 2007-08 school year principals were asked to use their supplemental allocation to support an Instructional Resource Teacher (coach) for their school if one was not in place. Next school year, every school will have an Instructional Resource Teacher as a result of supplemental allocations. Training for these positions will be coordinated through the Department of Teaching and Learning and Title I.
