- ◆ Although several subjects ask for a single binder because they may be turned in occasionally, a large “trapper” keeper or accordion files **is not a good choice**
- ◆ Flexible or soft pencil/pen pouch is helpful
- ◆ Students are expected to bring loose-leaf paper, sharpened pencil and other materials to class each day.
- ◆ It is suggested that each student have a flash drive
