

GLOSSARY OF TERMS

Third Friday Data Definitions

Boundary	The geographic area that determines where a student attends school
Students living in boundary area	K-5 children who reside in households within a school's boundary area
Students enrolled	K-5 students enrolled in the school on the 3rd Friday of September 2004
Building capacity	The maximum number of students the school can accommodate
% of capacity	The number of K-5 students living in the boundary area divided by the corresponding school's building capacity
% low income	The number of K-5 students living in the current boundary area that qualify for free/reduced lunch divided by the the total number of K-5 students

MOD Data Definitions

Adjusted enrollment	The number of K-5 students who will be enrolled after the proposed boundary changes based on 3rd Friday students.
% of capacity*	The number of K-5 students living in the proposed boundary area divided by the corresponding school's building capacity
% low income	The number of K-5 students living in the proposed boundary area that qualify for free/reduced lunch divided by the the total number of K-5 students

* NOTE: This changes in many options if a school is opened (e.g. Leopold, Hoyt) or closed.
